**E-safety**

- A recent school survey of yrs 5&6 pupils in South Glos reported that 48% of children had unsupervised access to the internet in their bedroom (a recent parent survey put the figure at 14%). 42% of children had lied about their age to get access to social networking (and other) sites.
- Do you have a computer at home?
- Is your child confident with using it independently?
- Do you know exactly what they are doing on the Internet?
- Do you feel sure you are able to protect them and guide them to use the Internet safely?



In the week of the 14<sup>th</sup> of December we will be running two drop-in sessions for parents, as follow up to an 'E-Safety Week' in school. These will focus on E-safety at home and aim to help parents to feel confident with safeguarding children on the Internet. We will discuss current activities that the children are taking part in at school and provide guidance and useful resources for keeping them safe at home.

Smellies      Raffle Prizes      Books      Chocolate - fun size bars, etc.

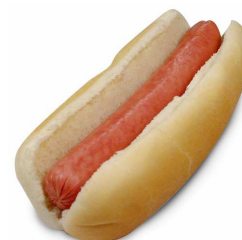
